The RPN will assess, plan, implement and evaluate patient care in consultation with physicians and other SCFHT members. You will be proficient in medication administration, immunization, dressing changes, suture removal, record keeping and vital signs collection and monitoring.

The successful applicant will have the following qualifications/experience:

- Be able to work Monday through Friday in a clinic located in Kenora, Ontario.
- Be self-directed with strong clinical, organizational, interpersonal, assessment and prioritization skills.
- Be current and in good standing with the College of Nurses of Ontario
- Be able to provide proof of professional liability insurance
- Be able to provide a valid CPR certificate
- Be able to provide a Criminal Record and Judicial Matters Check for the Vulnerable Sector
- Be able to provide proof of Automotive Liability Insurance with a minimum of two million coverage
- Be able to provide proof that they have completed the COVID-19 vaccination series as defined by the Ministry of Health; or Proof that they have started the vaccination series prior to commencing employment and will complete the series prior to completing the three (3) month probationary period.
