Social Worker (1 Full Time Permanent)

As part of the interdisciplinary team, the Social Worker assists in the primary care functions and participates in developing, implementing, monitoring, and evaluating the Sunset Country Family Health Team (SCFHT) programs and services for the individuals, families, and community. Working in collaboration with an interdisciplinary team, the Social Worker will play an integral part in improving the patient's mental health and social well-being. They will focus on coordinating and delivering health promotion and prevention programs.

Duties will include but are not limited to:

- Assist patients and families in navigating the local healthcare system
- Provide short-term counselling services
- Act as an advocate for patients and their families in matters affecting health
- Assist in the planning, implementation, and evaluation of programs to address patient and community needs
- Provide assessment and treatment for patients
- Perform cognitive assessments
- Participate in meetings and committee work as appropriate to support both clinical and organizational goals
- Promote SCFHT and uphold its mission and values
- Work in a manner that preserves confidentiality and seeks to minimize risks to the SCFHT and patients
- Help patients and staff to identify and utilize health resources
- Involve and empower patients in decisions about their health
- Plan, deliver and evaluate health education and other activities that assist, promote, and support patients as they strive to achieve their health goals
- Collaborate with other healthcare providers and patients where needed

The successful applicant will have the following qualifications/experience:

- A Bachelor of Social Work is required
- A Master of Social work is preferred
- Current registration with the Ontario Association of Social Workers
- Must be in good standing with the regulatory body
- Valid professional liability insurance is required
